Eugénio R. Duarte is a general superintendent in the Church of the Nazarene. At the time of his election, Dr. Duarte was serving as the Africa regional director for the denomination. Prior to that assignment he was the director for the Africa West and French Equatorial Fields. Dr. Duarte has also served as director for the Africa Lusophone Field, directing the start of Nazarene work in Equatorial Guinea, and as field director for Central Africa. Before this he was a teacher and the director of the Seminario Nazareno de Cabo Verde (SNCV), district superintendent of Cape Verde, and pastor of the Porto Novo and Mindelo Churches of the Nazarene.



Tim Green is ministering at Trevecca Nazarene University where he serves as Dean of the School of Religion, the Chaplain of the University, and Professor of Old Testament Literature and Theology. Prior to his ministry at Trevecca, he served in churches in Tennessee and Ohio. He received the M.A. and Ph.D. from Vanderbilt University in Old Testament studies.



Gordon MacDonald serves as chancellor of Denver Seminary and editor-at-large of *Leadership Journal*. He is an author, speaker, and teacher. He has provided leadership to influential ministries such as Inter Varsity Christian Fellowship, which he served as President for three years, and is a former Chairman of the Board of World Relief Corporation. Gordon's best-selling books include *Ordering Your Private World*, *Building Below the Waterline*, and *Going Deeper*.
