One of the aspects of NMF that I am most proud of is the fact that we don't have any money. What I mean by that is every penny we raise goes to buy bikes for missions through the Rusty Bellomy Bikes for Missions project. The folks who have served on the NMF Organizational Council these past seven years and those who you have elected to represent you on the NMF Advisory Council are all volunteers and they each pay their own way.

That all works fine until we go to General Assembly or one of the Mid Quadrennial conferences like M15 this past February. For the General Assemblies in 2009 and 2013 and for the Mid Quadrennial conferences in 2007, 2011, and 2015 we incurred expenses for the booth and just ponied up and paid for it ourselves.

At the last Advisory Council meeting it was suggested that we might want to offer the NMF Associates and anyone else for that matter the opportunity to support what we are calling the NMF General Fund. The General Fund would be where we would keep some funds on hand to pay for things like booth rental fees, and all the things that are a part of the cost of the conferences and General Assemblies we attend.

NMF Advisory Council members would still be volunteers and would continue to cover all personal expenses related to NMF.

Rusty Bellomy Project Update

In this section we will keep you up to date on the status of the Rusty Bellomy Bikes for Missions Project. How many applications are waiting to be filled? How much money is needed to fill those needs? How much money has been sent in so far? How many Rusty Bellomy bikes have been purchased? How are those bikes being used? We have most of that information available to us, but you may have a story about how your church, or your biker group, or your VBS kids raised those dollars. We want to share those stories. The latest totals from the Rusty Bellomy Bikes for Missions account show that by the time the Advisory Council meets in Lewistown in October, we should have around \$25,000 to use in assigning bikes. With an average price of \$1,700 per bike we should be able to assign 14 or 15 more bikes to the work of the kingdom. Praise the Lord! We currently have 32 applications for bikes waiting to be assigned.

Well, the council did meet, and we assigned those bikes, which now brings the total number of bikes in service around the world to 62. Praise the Lord!!

Then at M15 we assigned another 3 bikes with the funds on hand so the new total is 65 bikes in the Rusty Bellomy project!

The Rusty Bellomy Bikes for Missions Project donates bikes to missionaries around the world to help them spread the gospel of Jesus Christ. As a result of contributions from churches, biker groups, and individuals, enough funds are available to purchase and distribute bikes to pastors who have submitted motorcycle funding requests.
