Modular Course of Study (MCOS) to Non-Degree Course of Study (NCOS)

This transfer table allows districts to know which courses in the Modular Course of Study (2002) transfer into the Non-Degree Course of Study (2026). In the transition from the MCOS to the NCOS, we hope to take a generous approach, honoring the student's previous studies in the MCOS. To use this transfer table, identify which courses the student has taken in the MCOS and award credit for the corresponding NCOS course. While this transfer table is offered as a helpful guide, districts should carefully evaluate the student's educational record and make a final determination on transfer courses.
